## LITTLE LEAGUE ONTARIO ROUND ROBIN FORMAT for 8 TEAMS

APPROVED FOR USE in 2010 LL ONTARIO PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

\*\* Host team is district winner under this format.

### Tiebreakers and Playoff Round:

1. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place within each pool goes into the playoff round.
2. If two teams are tied with 2-1 record, the winner of the game between them gets 1<sup>st</sup> place and the other team is 2<sup>nd</sup>.
3. If three teams are tied for first place, then the run differential statistic in the Canadian Tournament Guidelines will be used to determine which team gets 1<sup>st</sup> place, and the other two teams play a tiebreaker game with the winner getting 2<sup>nd</sup> place.
4. If three teams are tied for second place, the run differential statistic in the Canadian Tournament Guidelines will be used to determine which team gets the bye and the other two teams play a tiebreaker game. The winner plays the team which received the bye and the winner of that game gets second place.
5. Game 1: 1<sup>st</sup> in pool 1 plays 2<sup>nd</sup> in pool 2  
Game 2: 1<sup>st</sup> in pool 2 plays 2<sup>nd</sup> in pool 1  
Final: winner game 1 plays winner game 2
